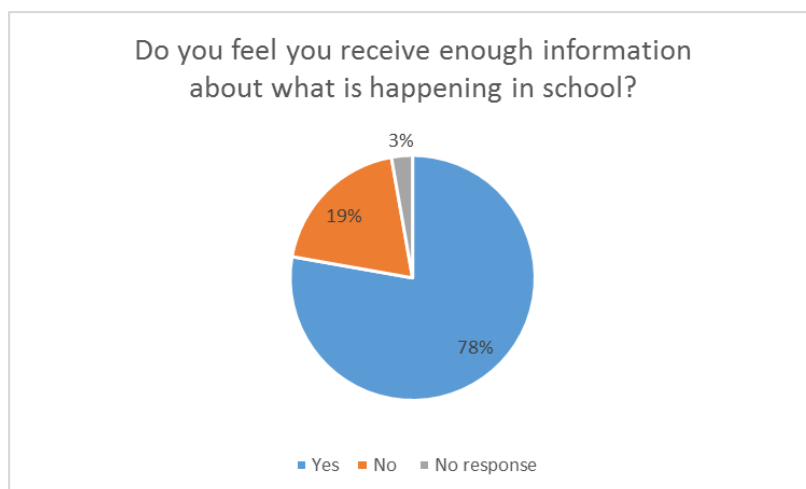
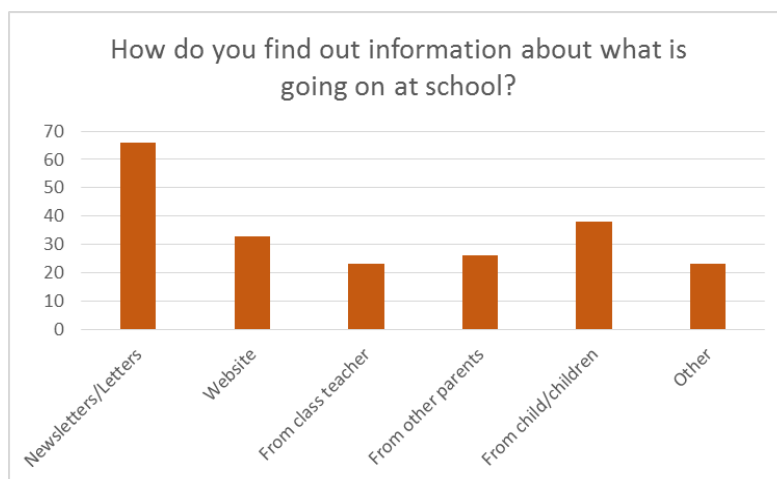
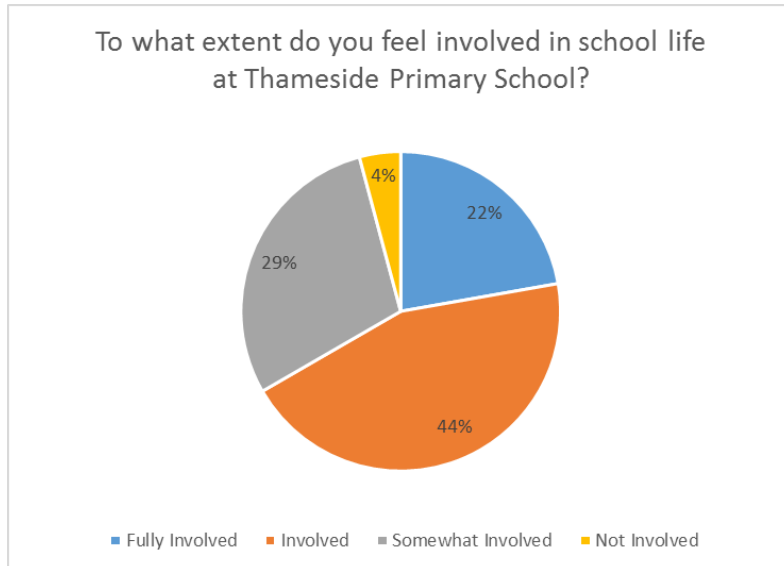
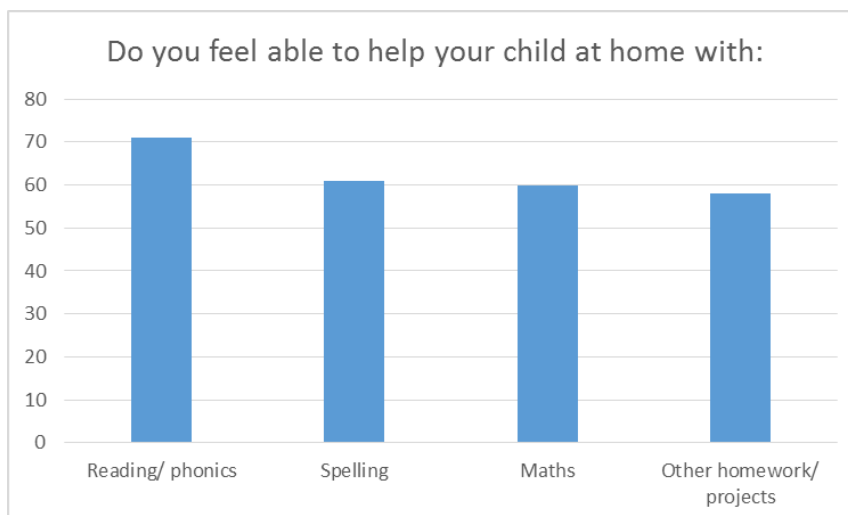
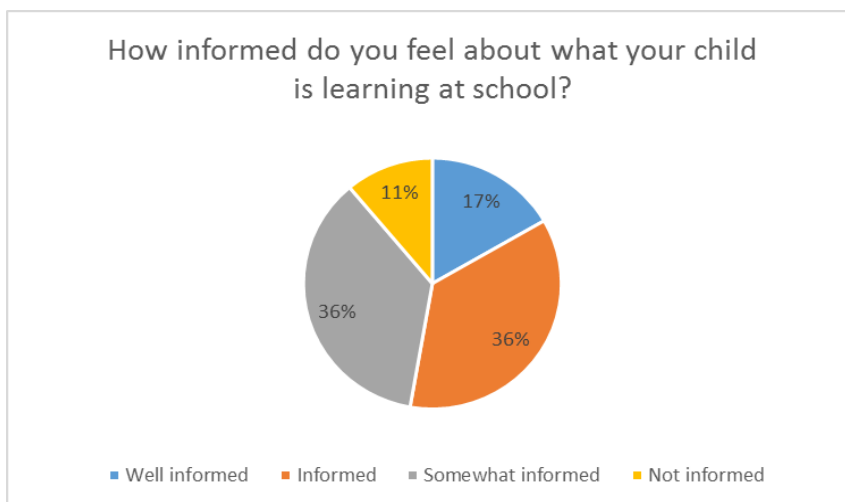
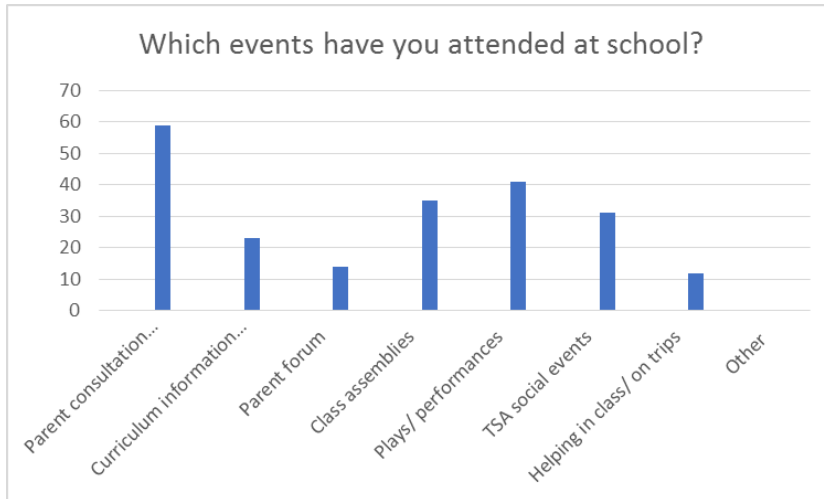


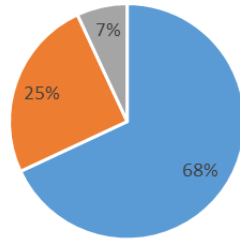
72 parents responded to the questionnaire which represents 25% of our families. A summary of the results is being sent out this week (by letter).

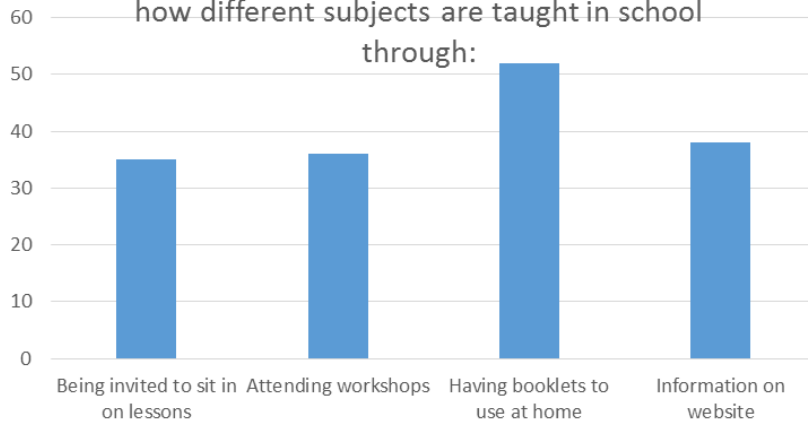


Do you think the school provides parents with sufficient information to enable them to help their children at home?

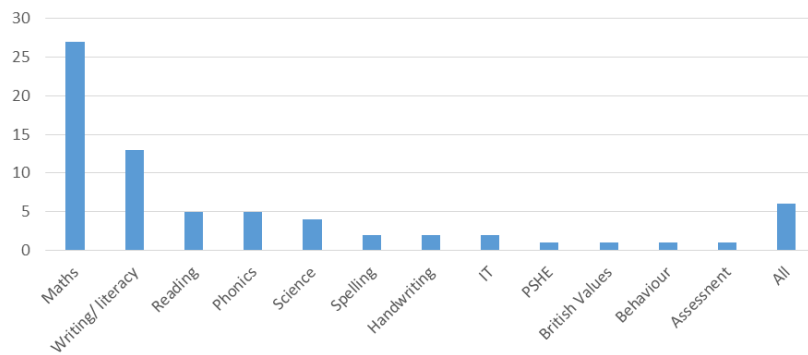


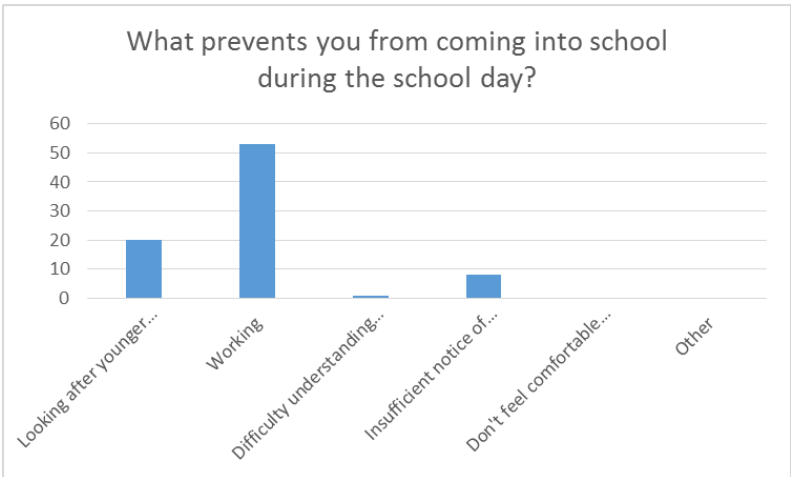
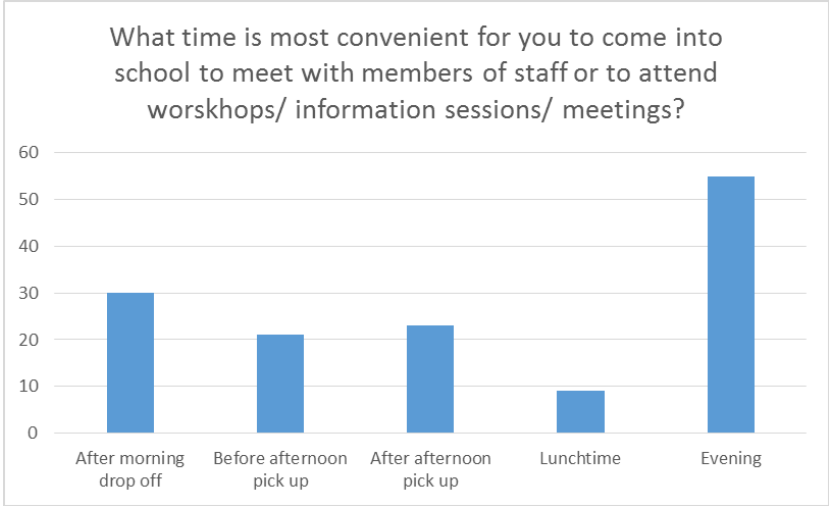
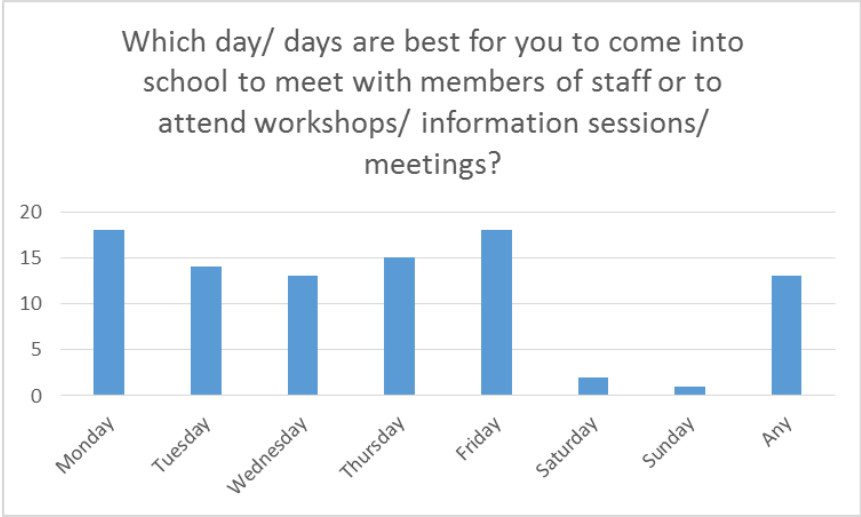

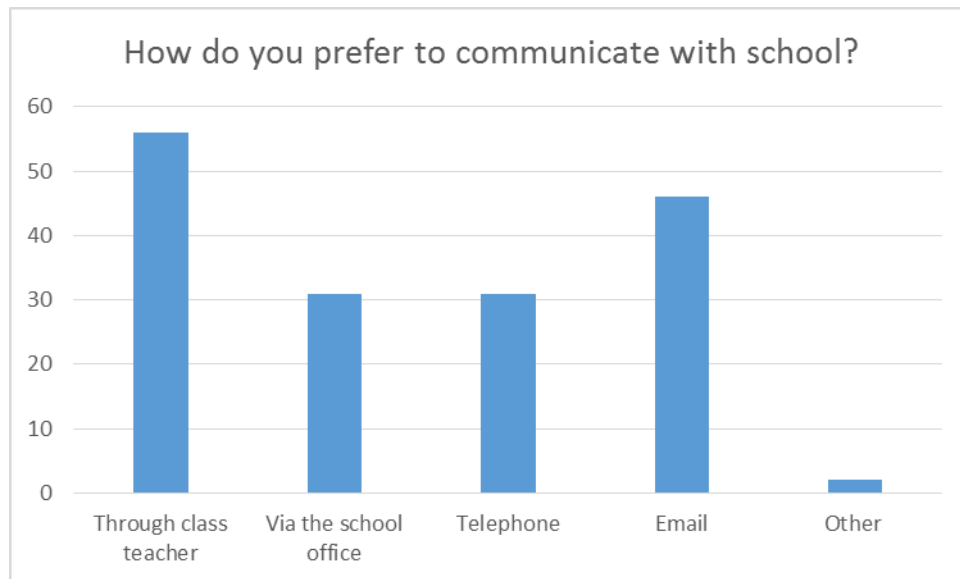
Would you be interested in learning more about how different subjects are taught in school through:

School Actions

- More notice of school events given where possible
- Letters on the website as they are sent so that lost/ mislaid letters can still be accessed
- Ask parents to sign up for the email service so that letters are sent home directly
- Better signposting to the wealth of information available to help your child
- Better signposting to the information that tells you what your child is learning
- Information booklet on phonics to be written
- Parents are now invited to sit in on lessons following class assemblies
- Consider holding workshops at different times of the day (this is dependent on the space available and also covering teachers)
