

2022 Results Summary

Good Level of Development in Foundation Stage (2022):

GLD is a performance measure for EYFS pupils. Children are defined as having reached a good level of development at the end of the EYFS if they have achieved at least the expected level in:

- The early learning goals in the prime areas of learning (personal, social and emotional development; physical development; and communication and language)
- The early learning goals in the specific areas of mathematics and literacy.

61% of our pupils achieved GLD

Phonics (2022)

Year 1 Phonics: 70% achieved the expected standard

Year 2 Phonics: 91% of our pupils are working at the expected standard in phonics

KS1 (2022)

READING: Expected standard +	72%
READING: Exceeding (higher standard)	46%
WRITING: Expected standard +	65%

In 2022, our Year 6 writing was moderated by the Local Authority.
