



2023 Results Summary

Good Level of Development in Foundation Stage (2023):

GLD is a performance measure for EYFS pupils. Children are defined as having reached a good level of development at the end of the EYFS if they have achieved at least the expected level in:

- The early learning goals in the prime areas of learning (personal, social and emotional development; physical development; and communication and language)
- The early learning goals in the specific areas of mathematics and literacy.

73% of our pupils achieved GLD

Phonics (2023)

Year 1 Phonics: 77% achieved the expected standard
