As part of our topic 'The Vikings', we have organised a topic day which will be run by staff during normal school hours on Monday 11 February 2019. Throughout the day, children will take part in various Viking related activities and this is a fantastic opportunity for them to experience lots of 'hands on learning'.

All children are invited to come to school dressed as a Viking. Costumes are easily made from existing clothing and there is no need to get something from a fancy dress shop.

Here are some ideas:

Viking Warrior

- A long sleeved, oversize plain T-shirt, any colour but muted ones are best.
- A thin belt, leather or fabric. A plain tie-belt from a dressing gown will do.
- A pair of plain dark leggings or jogging bottoms
- Plain dark shoes or short boots

Viking Lady

- A plain coloured long dress or top and skirt
- A plain long tabard-style apron (this can just be a rectangle of fabric with a hole cut in it for the head)
- A thin belt
- A pair of round or oval badges or brooches, one to be worn on each side of the chest just below the collar bone
- A string of beads to hang between the two brooches
- Plain dark shoes or short boots
- Hair plaited in a single plait at the back
